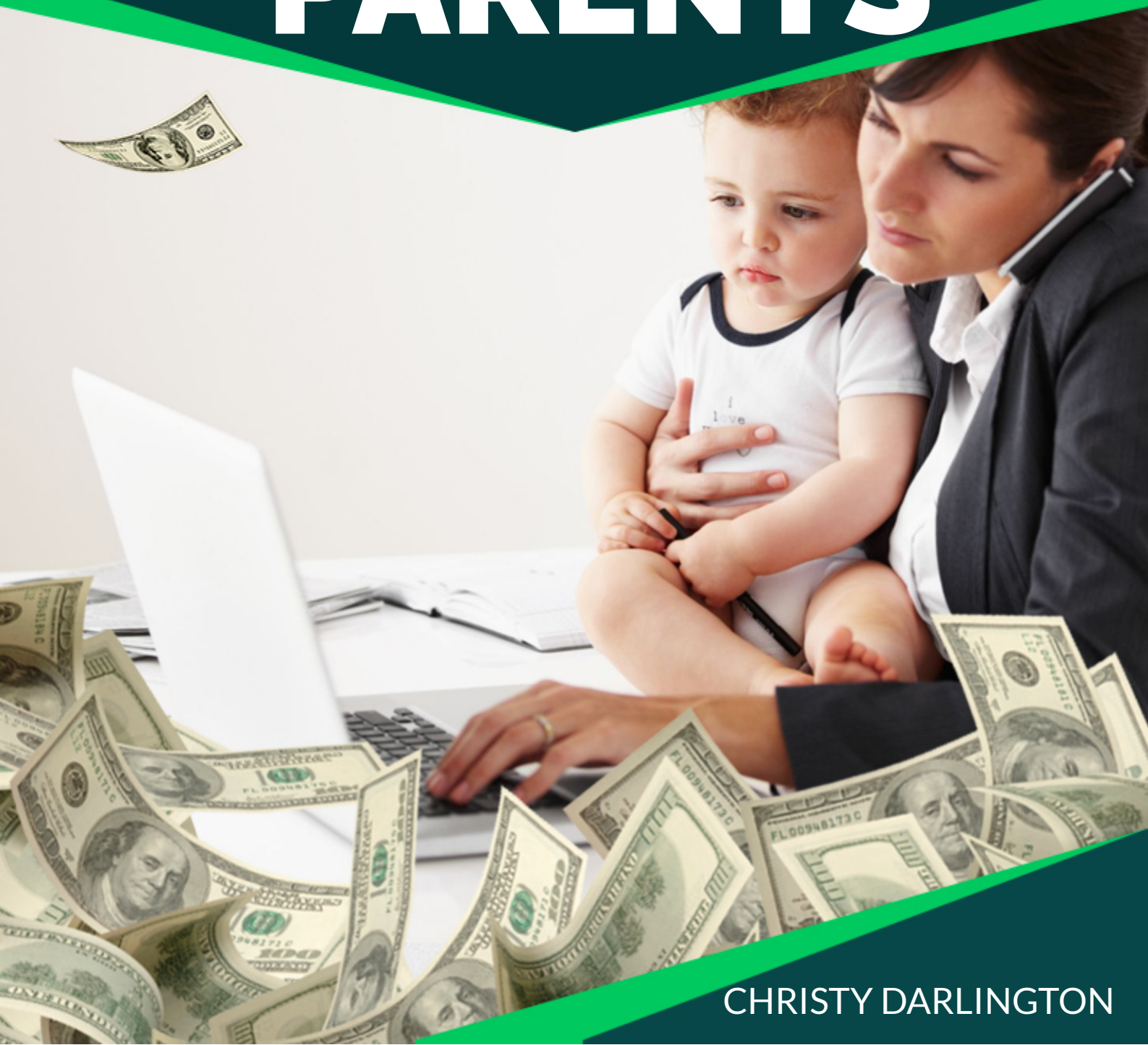

We recommend selecting a niche you are passionate about and knowledgeable in. This will enable you to create relevant and engaging content for your target audience. Along with leveraging free SEO traffic to grow your audience through social media platforms and backlinks, you can also use advertising networks like Google AdSense, Facebook, and YouTube Ads to promote and sell digital products or services. This will enable you to collect email addresses from your audience that you can retarget with links to your blogs through email automation.

Popular niches include health and wellness, relationships, technology, finance, beauty, and home improvement. Utilizing popular Affiliate networks like Amazon Associates, ShareASale or ClickBank, we will help you find and promote products or services made by others to help you earn a commission for each sale made through your referral links posted on your blog niche website. This is a popular way to generate passive income online because you create a digital asset once and then it sits on the internet generating affiliate earnings whenever people engage with your content.

Step-by-Step Process to Do Affiliate Marketing Through Your Website:

1. **Choose Your Niche:** Focus on a niche that interests you and has a demand in the market. This helps you create relevant and engaging content for your audience.

Popular affiliate networks include the following: Amazon Associates, ShareASale, ClickBank, JVZoo, CJ Affiliate, and Rakuten. These programs provide you with unique referral links to track your sales and earnings.
4. **Create Quality Content** on your Website blog and YouTube channel answering people's questions in your related niche. When you create content, keep in mind that it needs to provide real value to your audience without it sounding like sales pages. You want it to look more like an informative blog with links to a variety of options your audience can consider to solve their problems or increase their success with your chosen niche. You can also provide product reviews, tutorials, comparisons, and informative articles on your blog to help create further engagement with your content.
5. **Incorporate Affiliate Links:** Naturally integrate your affiliate links into your content by ensuring your links are relevant to your topic and add value to your audience. Strategically place call-to-action phrases like "Check out this product," "Learn more here," or "Buy now" to encourage clicks on your affiliate links.

2. Dropship Physical Products:

Dropshipping is a business model where you sell physical products without holding any inventory. When a customer places an order on your online store, you purchase the item from a third-party supplier who then ships it directly to the customer. This allows you to run a retail business with minimal overhead. While this model requires some management since you act as the mediator between your customer and the supplier, it provides a way to grow your email list quickly through paid traffic, with the advertising costs covered by product sales.

Experience shows that customers who purchase a physical product are ten times more likely to buy a related digital membership compared to those who are only offered the digital membership. Therefore, combining a membership or recurring revenue stream with a physical product offer can significantly boost your monthly income through paid traffic.

In our 4-Step Passion Profit System, we teach you how to set up a WooCommerce store and add physical products from dropshipping suppliers that appeal to your niche website's targeted audience. We look for unique products priced between \$20-\$80 that aren't readily available on Amazon. We test the market interest by identifying similar products on Amazon with over 100 recent sales, importing the chosen product to our dropshipping store, and creating YouTube videos about it. If we get over 1,000 organic views, we can be confident it will sell well with Facebook advertising and other platforms.

Since Facebook prefers video ads, we create a video ad using images from our supplier or our own photos/videos if we purchase the product first. To keep ad costs low, we set a budget of \$5 per day for three days. If the ad at least breaks even, we continue promoting it, making it the "signature product" for our passive income funnel system. A good conversion metric to aim for is a 30-40% membership upgrade from the physical signature product you are selling at the front end of your funnel. If these metrics continue to hold as you market your signature product, this can provide a consistent revenue stream that can passively grow over time without additional advertising costs.
